

Overview of the Farbrengen

All the Sichos and the Ma'amor have subtitles in English aside for Sicha 5 (the Hadran), Sicha 6-7 (about MiHu Yehudi). Those have subtitles only in Yiddish!

Niggun Hisvaadus

The Farbrengen starts with a Niggun – last **10 Minutes**.

Sicha 1

Sicha 1 – Contemplating on the opening of Bosi Le'Gani – the world is good.

The full length of the Sicha itself is **20 Minutes**.

Niggun Yosisu Ve'Yismichu afterwards for about **8 minutes**.

Sicha 2

Sicha 2 – Reconciling the above with the Din of Ger.

The full length of the Sicha itself is **18 Minutes**.

Niggun Ashreinu afterwards for about **10 Minutes**. (Reb Y Piekarski approaches in middle).

Sicha 3

Sicha 3 – Why Davka a Gan?

The full length of the Sicha is **17 Minutes**.

Niggun Hu Elokeinu afterwards for about **5 minutes**.

Niggun Hachona for the Ma'amor: **2 Minutes**.

[**Please note:** The first three Sichos are somewhat of a Hemshech and are **very Geshmak** - although Jem skipped the second Sicha in all the playlists.]

Ma'amor

Ma'amor – Bosi LeGani.

The Ma'amor lasts about **25 Minutes**.

Niggun VaYehi Bimei afterwards for about **10 minutes**. (Rabbi Yalles from Philadelphia, Rabbi David Hollander, and Rabbi Berel Rivkin approach the Rebbe; one after the other).

[**Please note:** The Ma'amor was learnt by many of the Bochorim this year and has subtitles in English. You might want to show it.]

Sicha 4

Sicha 4 – Shiras Moshe/Shiras Devorah?

The full length of the Sichra is **18 Minutes**.

Niggun Hallelu afterwards for about **6 minutes**. (The Rebbe encourages very strongly).

Sicha 5

Sicha 5 – Hadran on Middos (No English Subtitles)

The full length of the Sichra is **37 Minutes**.

Niggun Klimovitch afterwards for about **6 minutes**. (Rabbi Yalles approaches again. At the end - the Rebbe speaks with someone from far and asks that he say LeChaim).

Sicha 6

Sicha 6 – Mihu Yehudi - 1 (No English Subtitles)

The full length of the Sichra is **54 Minutes**.

Niggun Utzu Aitza afterwards for about **14 Minutes**. (Through most of it, the Rebbe speaks with Rabbi Simcha Elberg).

Sicha 7

Sicha 6 – Mihu Yehudi - 2 (No English Subtitles)

The full length of the Sichra is **16 Minutes**.

Niggun Utzu Aitza afterwards for about **2 Minutes**.

Sicha 8

Sicha 6 – Magbis for Torah Lishma.

The full length of the Sichra is about **1 Minute**.

The Rebbe distributes Mashke to some participants (new immigrants from Russia).

And then the crowd sings **Niggun VeHarikosi** afterwards. Total: **9 Minutes**.

Sicha 9

Sicha 9 – Activities with the Yidden from Russia

The full length of the Sichra is **10 Minutes**.

Niggun Hachona for the Alter Rebbe's Niggun afterwards for about **3 Minutes**. (A Bar mitzvah boy and his father approach the Rebbe and receive Mashke).

Russian Niggun - The Rebbe asks for a Russian Niggun. They sing *Ivadyemi*. (The Rebbe motions to whistle).

Kol Sasson - The Rebbe asks Dovid from Georgia to sing a Niggun, he sings Kol Sasson, and then the Rebbe asks again for *Ivadyemi*. Total: about **5 Minutes**.

Sicha 10

Sicha 10 – Shabbos Shira/end.

The full length of the Sichra is **5 Minutes**.

Alter Rebbe's Niggun/Nye Zhuritz - The Rebbe stands up to Dance during Nye zhuritz.

Nyet, Nyet - After making a Brocha Acharona, the Rebbe begins "Nyet, Nyet" and leaves the Shul.

Total: about **7 Minutes**.
